Grand Prize - Wear the watch awarded to the winner of the Opera House Cup Regatta -- the limited edition **Panerai Luminor 1950 Regatta Rattrapante**. The watch features automatic OP XVIII caliber movement and a highly specialized split-second chronograph and chronometer that counts down the minutes to the start of a regatta. It is a genuine sailor's instrument. It comes with a leather strap, steel case and buckle blackened with a diamond-like-carbon coating for resistance to corrosion and scratching, packaged in a

wooden presentation case. Case 44 mm. Valued at \$17,000!
