As you'll remember during the 2010 Nantucket Race Week, Nantucket Community Sailing (NCS) recognized a number of organizations that in the opinion of Community Sailing and the panel of judges made a meaningful contribution to the cleanliness of Nantucket's harbors and waters. Recipients were surprised by this recognition and we hope that their success will lead to other institutions becoming active in working for a Clean Harbor.

Thus, it is with great pleasure – indeed excitement – that we are letting you know that NCS will again make a similar award during this year's Nantucket Race Week and as judges we are seeking to identify organizations or individuals who, over the last year, have contributed to an improvement in the health of our aquatic resources. Unlike last year, awards will be made on the basis of a submitted application that will be reviewed by the judges for a recommendation to NCS. We are asking respondents to identify their Clean Harbor objective; what they have done in the last year to improve cleanliness, and how they have done it. Off-water activities that reduce or clean up run off or improve the health of our aquifers also qualify for consideration.
