### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of the US national authority will not apply: Prescriptions to Rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4.
- 1.3 Protest arbitration may be offered and will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing authority.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The series will be sailed in International One Design boats, owned by the Nantucket International One Design Fleet Association, Inc.

- 3.2 All skippers must be Regular Members of the Nantucket Yacht Club or be officially approved by the Nantucket Yacht Club as a monthly or seasonal Racing Guest.
- 3.3 Skippers must be either members of the NIODFA or Approved Substitute Skippers, pursuant to the NIODFA By-Laws.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at [www.nantucketraceweek.org](http://www.nantucketraceweek.org) (click on Registration Tab) and submitting the entry form, together with the required fee, by no later than August 8, 2011.
- 3.5 The organizing authority, may in its sole discretion, accept any late entry.
- 3.6 All Skippers should be members of US Sailing.

**4 FEES**

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$65, if received on or before August 8, 2011, of which \$40 is tax deductible as a charitable contribution to Nantucket Community Sailing.
- 4.2 Your entry fee for the IOD Series allows you to register for the Sail Nantucket Regatta at no additional cost, although you must register for Sail Nantucket in order to compete.
- 4.3 Registrations received after August 8, 2011, are subject to an additional late fee of \$25 for a total of \$90, of which \$65 is a tax deductible contribution to NCS. Participating boats must complete their registration no later than their first day of racing.
- 4.4 Tickets for all Nantucket Race Week social events may be purchased at [www.nantucketraceweek.org](http://www.nantucketraceweek.org) (click on registration tab) or at the NRW regatta desk located at Nantucket Yacht Club. Space is limited. Please make reservations early.

**6 SCHEDULE**

- 6.1 IOD races for this Regatta will be held on Sunday, August 14, as part of the IOD August Series, and Saturday, August 20, as part of the Sail Nantucket Regatta.

**7 VENUE**

All races will be held in Nantucket Sound and nearby waters.

**8 SCORING**

The Low Point Scoring System will be used for each day and the series.

**9 PRIZES**

- 9.1 Daily awards will be presented immediately after racing each day.
- 9.2 Nantucket Race Week trophies will be presented to the top three overall series finishers at the Sail Nantucket awards ceremony at Nantucket YC after racing on Saturday, August 20, 2011.
- 9.3 The top-performing skipper in a one design fleet will also receive a special Nantucket Race Week prize, to be presented at the awards ceremony at Nantucket YC on August 20.

**10 DAMAGES**

Damages for at-fault skippers will be limited to \$2000 per incident. Damage to a boat shall be borne by the team sailing the boat when the damage occurred, or by the team responsible for the damage in the judgment of the Organizing Authority; or if caused while racing, by the team deemed at fault for the incident, as determined by the Protest Committee. If no protest is filed because the at-fault boat retired or accepted a penalty pursuant to the RRS, they shall be held responsible for any damage from an incident. If damage occurs as a result of an incident between boats, and neither boat delivers a protest, then the boats involved in the incident shall be held equally responsible. If a boat is damaged such that it cannot race in subsequent races and no other boats are available, the responsible team will be ineligible to race until the boat is returned to service. In such event, the team who would have next held the damaged boat in the rotation will instead sail the boat that the responsible team was to have next held in the rotation.

**11 EVENT MERCHANDISE**

Merchandise for Nantucket Race Week will be available at the event.

**12 CLEAN REGATTA**

Nantucket Race Week is committed to maintaining Nantucket's clean waters and shores. As such, Nantucket Race Week is registered in the Sailors for the Sea's Clean Regattas program. All NRW participants are encouraged to follow the goals and requirements of Clean Regattas. The requirements include:

- a) No discharge of treated or untreated sewage or black water in harbor areas or no-discharge zones around Nantucket.
- b) No overboard discharge of trash or littering at shore facilities (e.g., rigging tape, cigarette butts, beer cans).

- c) Follow Nantucket's trash and recycling guidelines: Trash must be in clear plastic or biodegradable bags. All paper, glass, metal, and plastic must be recycled and placed in separate containers.
- d) Reduce plastic waste by using refillable water bottles.
- e) Use green cleaning and maintenance products.
- f) Reduce the impact of oil spills from motorized vessels by carrying at least one bilge sponge and fuel spill pad.

**13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers, Nantucket Race Week LLC, the Nantucket Yacht Club, Great Harbor Yacht Club, Nantucket Community Sailing, the NIODFA, race committee, protest committee, volunteers, sponsors, agents, employees, or any other organization or official providing services at the request of any of the foregoing in connection with the events will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any person sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor (owners, skippers, and crews) agrees to release the race organizers and all persons and groups listed above from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
