1 RULES

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Prospective participants may request an invitation by completing the registration form at www.nantucketraceweek.org (click on Registration tab) and then submitting the entry form, together with the required fee, by no later than August 8, 2011.
- 3.2 The organizing authority, may, in its sole discretion, accept any late entry.

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$25, if received on or before August 8, 2011. The registration fee includes entry for one person to the Family BBQ at Great Harbor Yacht Club on Monday, August 15.

Sunday, August 14

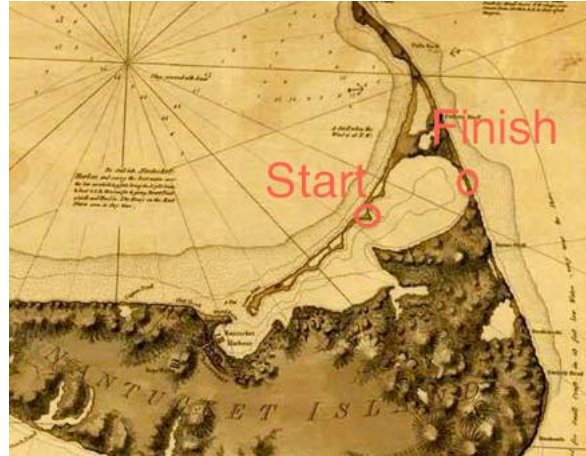
1300	Check in at Bass Point near flags. If not enough wind before 1600 event is cancelled.

7 VENUE

The race will take place launching from Bass point. Competitors should sail over from Pocomo Point or take a ride on the NCS Skiffs that will be available.



8 COURSES

Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

Sailor that makes it to the finish first wins, the 2nd second, 3rd to the finish gets 3rd. Awards will be given for both windsurfing and kiteboard participants.

10 PRIZES

Awards will be presented at an awards ceremony on Monday, August 15 at Great Harbor Yacht Club.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. Personal communications not related to racing are permitted.

12 SAFETY

All competitors should wear normal windsurf and kiting gear and take normal precautions as if you were sailing on your own. There will be skiffs for assistance

13 EVENT MERCHANDISE

Merchandise for Nantucket Race Week will be available at the event.

14 CLEAN REGATTA

Nantucket Race Week is committed to maintaining Nantucket's clean waters and shores. As such, Nantucket Race Week is registered in the Sailors for the Sea's Clean Regattas program. All NRW participants are encouraged to follow the goals and requirements of Clean Regattas. The requirements include:

- a) No discharge of treated or untreated sewage or black water in harbor areas or no-discharge zones around Nantucket.
- b) No overboard discharge of trash or littering at shore facilities (e.g., rigging tape, cigarette butts, beer cans).
- c) Follow Nantucket's trash and recycling guidelines: Trash must be in clear plastic or biodegradable bags. All paper, glass, metal, and plastic must be recycled and placed in separate containers.
- d) Reduce plastic waste by using refillable water bottles.
- e) Use green cleaning and maintenance products.
- f) Reduce the impact of oil spills from motorized vessels by carrying at least one bilge sponge and fuel spill pad.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers, Nantucket Race Week LLC, the Nantucket Yacht Club, Great Harbor Yacht Club, Nantucket

Community Sailing, race committee, protest committee, volunteers, sponsors, agents, employees, or any other organization or official providing services at the request of any of the foregoing in connection with the events will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any person sustained as a result of participation in this event.
