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The notation “[DPJ]” in a rule in this Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. US Sailing Prescriptions will apply.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the [Official Notice Board](#) three days prior to the regatta.

3. COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. The Official Notice Board is online at www.nantucketraceweek.org.
- 3.2. On the water the race committee will communicate verbally and/or by signals on a white board.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Entry is open to Club 420 Class boats.
- 4.2. Prior to entering, local sailors from NCS, NYC, or GHYC should have approval from their Program Director to participate in the NRW Youth 420 Regatta and to reserve a program boat for this event. Entrants who have not received this approval (it can be verbal) may not be eligible for participation and any fees will be refunded in full.
- 4.3. Club 420 sailors shall be juniors who have not reached their 19th birthday in 2025.
- 4.4. Nantucket applicants must be approved by their program head:

- 4.5. Applicants must complete the online entry form, including the waiver and medical, (click on the Sailing tab) by **Tuesday August 5th at 1800**.

5. FEES

- 5.1. The entry fee is \$35 per participant. There will be no lunch provided. Participants should bring water.

6. ADVERTISING

- 6.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1. The regatta will be sailed over two days”: August 7th and 8th, 2025.
- 7.2. There will be no competitors meeting. Coaches will verbally deliver instructions ahead of rigging at home clubs.
- 7.3. On Thursday, August 7th, the first warning signal will be at 1300.
- 7.4. On Friday, August 8th, the first warning signal will be at 1000.
- 7.5. No race will be started after 1530 on Thursday, August 7. No race will be started after 1430 on Friday, August 8.
- 7.6. Multiple races are planned each day.
- 7.7. Awards are scheduled at 1600 at Nantucket Yacht Club on Friday, August 8th.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. The available racing areas in Nantucket Harbor will be shown in the sailing instructions.



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9. COURSES

9.1. To be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1. The protest committee may impose penalties less than disqualification (DP), for violation of the class rules and racing rules other than those of RRS Part 1 and Part 2. This changes RRS 60.5(c).

11. SCORING

11.1. One completed race constitutes a regatta.

11.2. Boats will be scored in two Divisions: Green and Championship.

11.3. As permitted in RRS 90.3(b), when five or more races are completed, one worst score will be excluded, from that boat's series score. This modifies RRS A2.1.

11.4. Results will be posted on the NRW Website following the regatta.

12. SAFETY

12.1. All competitors shall wear, while on the water, US Coast Guard approved PFD, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment, in accordance with RRS 40.1. The penalty for breach of this rule is DSQ, without a hearing, in accordance with RRS 60.5(b)(3).

13. PRIZES

13.1. First, second, and third place prizes may be awarded in each Division.

13.2. The top-performing skipper in a one-design fleet during the entire week will also receive a special NRW prize.

14. CLEAN REGATTA

14.1. Nantucket Race Week is committed to maintaining Nantucket's clean waters and shores, and is certified by Sailors for the Sea as a gold-level Clean Regatta. All NRW participants are encouraged to follow the goals and requirements of the Clean Regatta Program.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers, Nantucket Race Week L.L.C., the Nantucket Yacht Club, Great Harbor Yacht Club, Nantucket Community Sailing, Race Committee, Protest Committee, Technical Committee, volunteers, sponsors, agents, employees, or any other organization or official providing services at the request of any of the foregoing in connection with the events will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property, or the injury, disease or illness to any person sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor (owners, skippers, crews and support persons) agrees to release the race organizers and all persons and groups listed above from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
